63. Farmer. Born in Scotland. Elizabeth
49. Born in NC. Chatham County, NC. (C)

WILLIAMSON JAMES B.
Born in Scotland(?) Nat.30 October 1825
New Hanover County, NC. (New Han Sup Ct Mins)

WILSON ALEXANDER
Born in Scotland. A planter in
St Bartholemew's parish, SC. (Pr 8.3.1798 SC)

WILSON DAVID
Born in Stirlingshire. Settled in SC
during 1825. Nat.25 April 1829
Newberry, SC. (Cit Book 119)

WILSON DAVID
58. Teacher. Born in Scotland. Jane M. 60.
Born in Pennsylvania. Beaufort County, SC. (C)

WILSON ELIZABETH
45. Born in Scotland. Angus 27. Teacher.

WILSON GEORGE
Son of David Wilson, merchant in Coupar
Angus, Perthshire. Surgeon in SC. (Pr 14.1.1791 SC)

Born in Edinburgh during 1803. A pilot
in Charleston. Nat.19 August 1826
Charleston, SC. (Nat Arch M1183.1)

WILSON HUGH

Born in Ayrshire during 1778. Married Janet ..., born in East Lothian during 1781. Father of William, born in Ayrshire in 1803, John, born in Ayrshire in 1812, Hugh, born in Ayrshire in 1820. Emigrated to SC in October 1822. Nat. 15 November 1827 Laurens County, SC. (Laurens Ct Roll 84)

WILSON HUGH

Born in Ayr during 1785. Nat.30 November 1823 SC. (Cit Book 99)

WILSON JACOBINA

Wife of Pate Mills Milner, planter in NC. Serviced as Heir to her father John Wilson, storekeeper in Virginia, during February 1771. (SRO/SH)

WILSON JAMES

Jacobite soldier captured after the Siege of Preston, Lancashire. Transported from Liverpool to South Carolina on the Wakefield, master Thomas Beck, 21 April 1716. (SPC)

WILSON JAMES

Born 14 September 1742, near St Andrews, Fife. Educated at the Universities of St Andrews, Glasgow and Edinburgh - graduated LL.D. Emigrated from Scotland to New York during 1765. Settled in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, during 1766. Married Rachel Bird in 1772. Academic, judge and politician. Died in Edenton, NC, on 21 August 1798. (AP)

WILSON JAMES

Eldest son of John Wilson in Stirling. Died in Charleston, SC, on 7 September 1804. (SM 66.973)

WILSON JAMES jr

Born in Angus during 1780. A merchant. Nat.10 December 1805 Charleston, SC. (Nat Arch M1183.1)

WILSON JAMES

Born in Leith, Midlothian, during 1774. Nat.13 July 1807 Charleston, SC. (Nat Arch M1183.1)

WILSON JANETTE

49. Born in Scotland. Abbeville County, SC. (C)

WILSON JOHN

Born in Lanarkshire during 1789. An engineer and surveyor in Charleston. Nat.7 May 1814 Charleston, SC. (Nat Arch M1183.1)

WILSON ROBERT

Born in Cupar, Fife(?), on 2 April 1736. Apprenticed to Dr Martin Eccles of the Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh. An apothecary and surgeon in Burntisland, Fife. Emigrated from London to SC as an indentured servant in September 1753. Married Ann Chisholm in Charleston, SC, on 8 April 1759. Father of Robert, 1770-1821. Died 26 August 1815. (BAF)(SA)(LGR)

WILLSON ROBERT

Emigrated from Scotland or Ireland on the ship Pearl, master Walter Buchanan, in December 1767. Allocated a 100 acre land grant on 12 December 1767. (OL)

WILSON SAMUEL

Born in Castle Douglas, Kirkcudbrightshire, c1802. Settled in SC c1819. Died on 20 October 1828. Buried in Columbia Presbyterian Cemetery. (SC State Gaz 25.10.1828)

WILSON WILLIAM

Born in Scotland during 1746. Married Nancy Green. Died in Rowan County, NC, during 1806. (INC27631)

WILSON WILLIAM

Born in Edinburgh during 1788. A butcher in Charleston. Nat.23 October 1813 Charleston, SC. (Nat Arch M1183.1)

WISHART Mr WILLIAM

Covenanter. Prisoner in Edinburgh or Canongate Tolbooths. Banished to Carolina. Transported from Leith to Carolina by Robert Malloch, merchant burgess of Edinburgh, during 1684. (PC)
