Item, all the rest of my estate I lend to my wife Rebecca Emory during of her widowhood, & after her death or marriage my desire is that all the Estate lent to my wife should be equally divided among all my living Children & Temperance Hilliard if she should be alive, & I do appoint James & Henry Abobuck whole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament, - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & date above written.
