her Decease all my Sands to my Son Sagarus.

Item, it is further my Will that after the decease of my well beloved
Wife that the Remainder part of my Estate be equally divided amongst all
my Children

Item, it is my Will, that if my Son Sagarus dies without lawful
Heirs, that my Son Sampson shall have all my Sands to him & his Heirs for
ever. In Witness whereof I the said Edwin Turner have hereunto set my own
affixed my Seal this 12th Day of September 1878.
