

In the name of God Amen. I Elizabeth Selby of this County being weak of Body but of perfect mind & memory calling to mind that it is decreed for all flesh once to die do make this my last will & Testament in manner & form as follows (viz) In primis I give my soul into the hands of Jesus Christ my blessed God & saviour. Item I give & bequeath unto my Grand daughter Rosanna Powell one negro man named Humphrey to have her hair cut she dying without hair then to my ~~son~~ Daniel Powell & his heirs for ever. Also to Rosanna Powell one feather bed & furniture. I give & bequeath to the daughter Elizabeth Selby five Shillings Sterne. all the rest of my property I do desire that it should be equally divided between Rosanna Powell & Daniel Powell. Item I do appoint my friends Isaac Bennett & Joseph Brasier my Executors to this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 5th day of Feb in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety five.
