

Elizabeth Mitchell Coe's Will

In the Name of God Amen I Elizabeth Mitchell of Halifax County  
State North Carolina being now very sick but of a perfect and sound mind  
& memory and understanding but willing to mend the uncertainty of life & the certaint  
ty of death do make & constitute this my last will & Testament in manner  
& form as following. I promise I give my soul to God that gave it to me in hopes  
that the Lord will receive it thro' the merit of my Gracious Redeemer, as to my  
body I give it to the earth from whence it was taken and that to be readily  
buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned and as to my  
earthly goods which it hath pleased God to give me I will & bequeath in  
manner & form as following. - I give & bequeath to my daughter Dorothy Williamson  
the Land plantation whereon I now live to her & her heirs forever also I give to  
my said daughter Dorothy my mare Scott to her and her heirs forever, and my  
further wish & desire is for all the rest & residue my Estate to be sold about  
the money arising therefrom to be equally divided between my two daughters  
Dorothy & Mary and for that more I constitute and appoint my son in Law  
George Williamson Auditor & Sole Executor of this my last will and  
Testament utterly revoking & annulling any other will & Testament <sup>that</sup> might  
have formally been made by me In witness whereof I have hereunto set  
my hand & seal this 11th day of August in the year of Our Lord Christ one  
thousand seven hundred & ninety eight -
