my last Will and Testament intending to dispose of all my worldly affairs not  
so humour may prompt but as Justice and Equity both to direct I must humbly  
commend my soul to the exclusive mercy of that Eternal Supreme Intelligent  
Being who giveth me life the first place it is my will and desire that  
the following slaves may be manumitted vizt Alex<sup>r</sup> & Richard my grown  
children & Polly woman with their present and future increase —  
only it is my will and desire that all my real and personal Estate be equally  
divided between my children share & share alike after paying my just debts leaving  
a sufficient maintenance for my beloved wife during her life time —  
And I do now appoint Willie Jones & William R. Davis Esquires my Executors of this  
my last Will and Testament renouncing all Wills heretofore made, the Testimony  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand seal this the 25<sup>th</sup> day of May 1789
