unto my son Nathaniel Merrill to him and his Heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Hester Merrill one Bed
and Furniture.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jemima Merrill also one
Bed and Furniture to them and their Heirs for ever.

Item my Will and desire is that all the Remainder of my Estate that
I have not given away be sold to pay my debts.

Item my Will and desire is that the Money due from Gardner Marshall
be and be in his hands for the schooling and Boarding my son Nathaniel Merrill

and Cloathing my Daughter Jamiah Abbott and after Schooling and Boarding my Son Nathaniel Abbott and Cloathing my Daughter Jamiah Abbott until she be thought by my Executor able and Old enough to Cloath her self, then if there should be any Money left in the said Executors hands.

Item, my Will and desire is that it be equally divided among my three Children and Lastly I do constitute and appoint my Friend Gardner Haynes, my Friend Richard Morcom, my Friend Ambrose Chester and my Friend Vincent Harper my whole and sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have set unto my hand and affix'd my seal this third day of December in the year Seven Thousand one hundred and eighty eight
