worldly things which God hath blessed me with I give & bequeath in the following
manner.

1st Item I give & bequeath to my son John Mallory one negro woman named Ellen & her two children
Horace & Susky.

2nd Item I give & bequeath to my son Francis Mallory
five pounds to be paid out of my Estate.

3rd Item I give & bequeath to my
son James Mallory 7 negroes their names as follows. Bob Jack Peter with
Hannah & her children Henry & Robin. also my household furniture

4th Item I give & bequeath to my son William Mallory five pounds to be paid out of my
Estate.

5th Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Nancy Pandal all the
negroes that she has now in possession. Peg & her children.

6th Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Mallory five negroes their
names are as follows. man Nancy Stephen Booker & Izra one man & child

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Patsy Poythrup two negroes which she has
now in possession Polly & her child.

Item I give & bequeath to my Grandson
James Mallory son of Francis Mallory one negro man by the name of Arthur

6th Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Mallory five negroes their
names are as follow. Ann Nancy Stephen Booker & Izra one man & Colb

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Patsy Poythres two negroes which she has
now in possession Polly & her child.

Item I give & bequeath to my Grandson
James Mallory Son of Francis Mallory one negro man by the name of Arthur
