This 21st day of October Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & eighty nine
 being in perfect mind & memory though advanced in Body feeling serious imper-
 fection & knowing the certainty of death have thought proper to state as follows
 my wish Desire & Constitution thus my last will & Testament revoking all others here-
 before made - Item It is my will and desire that my just debts should be paid
 and to promote that desirable object. It is my wish that all my estate of Horses
 Cattle Sheep Hogs & all my household & Kitchen furniture (except the bed that my
 wife has on) be sold at twelve months credit and a calculation of the money
 arising from such sale to be made & if it then appears that there is not a suffi-
 ciency made by such sale to discharge the debts against my Estate, then it is
 my wish that a part of the tract of Land I bought of Col^l William Eaton or the
 whole if necessary be sold by my Executors hereafter mentioned for the purpose
 of discharging the Balances appearing due from my Estate, But to take it off
 the said tract in such a manner as not to touch the ferry Road or any houses
 or my just debts the Residue of said Land if any to go to my daughter Eliza
 both Woody and at her return to go to her son Robert. Moody -
 Item I bind unto Rebecca Mops during her natural life or widowhood the manor
 plantation whereon I now live situated on Runnack River containing by deed
 two hundred & fifteen Acres to the same more or less on Conditions that the said
 Rebecca maintains that Mops who is to live with her in the enjoyment of
 said property & at her decease or marriage It is my wish that the said
 tract of Land should be untaxed & the money arising from said rents to be
 appropriated to the maintenance of said ^{maid} and at his decease the said Land
 to go Laurel & then here and his heirs forever - Item It is my will & desire
 that Rebecca Mops should have & hold

to go Ludwell & Allen him and his heirs forever - Item It is my will & desire
that Rebecca Moff should have & possess during her life my three negroes
Sam, Bob, & Toby and at her decease that Sam should go William & Allen
his heirs Bob & Toby to Frederick Moore his heirs - I hereby appoint my
friends Col. Gilliam & Rowson & W. J. Hamilton my Executors at this my last
Last will & Testament Given under my hand this day & date above written
