Serving Black listed Servant to serve one two Year hereafter
I Give to my Grandson Elias Bell one load's Gunpowder
& two Sacks of a blaw & the other Redness one Iron
Skillet, I Give to my Granddaughter Ann Bell one
Dress of Batt, I Give to my loving Wife Anne Bell my
Mares & Cattle & the Young Hord left I had of Elizabeth
Leary I Give to my Granddaughter Bell the use of my two
Wells for so her lifetime as her lands I Give my three
Sister to my Grandson Elias Bell & my friend Jacob to my
Granddaughter Ann Bell, Next, I Give & bequeath to my
loving Wife Anne Bell all the Rest of my Estate per-
sonal & Real & do Appoint my well beloved Wife my
Whole & Sole Executrix of this my last Will & Test
I Cancel & I do revoke all other Wills made in my
Name or by me In Witness where of I have
hereunto set my hand & Seal this 25 Day of February
in the Year 1762 - George ^{his} Bell Signed
Made in the presence of us Thomas Joyner Joseph
By Rachel Bell & Halifax St. March Court 1762
This Will was Exhibited in open Court in Bath at the Spring
& Holy Court by the Father of Joel Hobby & Rachel Bell
two of the Subscribing Witnesses there to whom their
Oaths did say they saw Thomas Joyner Sign the sd.
Will as a Witness whereupon Anne Bell the Executrix in
the sd Will was duly Qualified by taking the
Oath lay Law directed; Ordered the sd Will be recorded
