County in mth Carolina being sick and weak of body  
yet of perfect sense & memory thinks he to god and on  
consideration that life and sense is uncertain  
do make and ordain this my last will and Test-  
ament Viz: I give and recommend my soul into  
the hands of god that gave it and my body I recom-  
mend to the Earth at the discretion of my exec-  
utors as to my worldly estate I give all mine  
Bequeath and dispose of the same in the following  
manner Viz: I primitively give and Bequeath all  
to my daughter Sarah Cudip the plantation  
whereon I now live with two hundred and  
fifty acres of land belonging thereto to the same  
more or less & also give to him the said Joe iah  
and Guess I also give to him five negroes namely  
Jack, Bott, Joe, Ishmael and Herley, I also give  
to him that lease land that I leased. I also give  
him all my chattels of what kind soever they be  
all the plantation utensils to him his heirs and as-  
signees forever, Also I give and Bequeath to  
my daughter Mary Cudip two hundred and  
eighty acres of land belonging thereto  
to the same more or less lying on Big ~~Brook~~  
Branch I also give to her six negroes namely  
Mike and Burbary I also give to her one  
feather Bed and furniture and one Black  
Walnut-Chest to her and her heirs forever  
Lastly I appoint George Wimbley sen: and Wm  
Horn executors of this my last will and Tes-  
tament and I do hereby disavow every other  
former will and Testament and do Ratifie  
and confirm this my last will and Test-  
ment

Bequeath and dispose of the same in the following  
manner viz? Imprimis I give and Bequeath all  
to my Servant Joseph Crudup the plantation  
whereon I now live with Two hundred and  
fifty acres of land belonging thereto to the sume  
more or less & also give to him the said Joseph  
all my stock consisting of Cattle Hogs & Sheep  
and Geese I also give to him five negroes Namely  
Jack, Bob, Joe Johnson and Herley, I also give  
to him that Land found that I leased. I also give  
him all my chattels of what kind soever they be  
all the plantation utensils to him his heirs and  
assigns forever I also give and Bequeath to  
my daughter Mary Crudup Two hundred and  
fifty acres of land belonging thereto  
At the same more or less lying on Big ~~Branch~~  
Basket I also give to her lots negroes namely  
Mike and Burbary I also give to her one  
Feather Bed and furniture and one Black  
Walnut Chest to her and her heirs forever  
so let I appoint George Wimbley servt and Wm  
Horn executors of this my last will and testa-  
ment and I do hereby disown every other  
former will and testament and do Ratifie  
and Confirm this my last will and testament  
in witness whereat I make hereunto set my  
hand and Seal the 21<sup>st</sup> day of March  
1764

Halifax for July Court 1764 this last will and  
Testament of George Crisp deceased was exhibited &
