Do make and ordain this my last will and tes-
tament Viz: I give and recommend my soul into
the hands of god that give it and my body I recom-
mend to the earth at the discretion of my exe-
cutors as to my worldly estate I give all mine
Bequeath and dispose of the same in the following
manner viz: Imprimis I give and Bequeath
to my Brother Josiah Cradup the plantation
whereon I now live with two hundred and
fifty acres of land belonging thereto to the same
more or less I also give to him the said Josiah
all my stock consisting of Cattle Hogs & Hens
and geese I also give to him five negroes Namely
Jack, Bots, Joe, John and Herby, I also give
to him that last land that I leased. I also give
him all my cloaths of what kind soever they be
all the plantation debts to him his heirs and ex-
-ecutors forever, I then I give and Bequeath to
my daughter Mary Cradup two hundred and
eighty acres of land belonging thereto
to the same more or less lying on Pig ~~Brook~~
-Brook I also give to her two negroes namely
Mike and Burtary I also give to ~~her~~ her one
feather Bed and furniture and one black
Walnut Chest to her and her heirs forever
Lastly I appoint George Wintley sent. and Wm
Horn Executors of this my last will and tes-
tament and I do hereby disannul every other
former Will and Testament and do Ratify
and confirm this my last will and testament

Bequeath and dispose of the same in the following
manner viz: Inprimis I give and Bequeath all
to my Brother Josiah Cradip the plantation
whereon I now live with Two hundred and
fifty acres of land belonging thereto to the same
more or less I also give to him the said Josiah
all my stock consisting of Cattle Hogs Horses
and Geese I also give to him five negroes Namely
Jack, Bob, Joe, John and Herby, I also give
to him that Last Land that I leased. I also give
him all my Cloaths of what kind soever they be
all the plantation Attchels to him his heirs and as-
signes forever. I then I give and Bequeath to
my daughter Mary Cradip Two hundred and
eighty acres of land belonging thereto
to the same more or less lying on Pig ~~Bar-~~
-Basket I also give to her two negroes namely
Mike and Burtary I also give to her one
feather Bed and furniture and one Black
Walnut Chest to her and her heirs forever
Lastly I appoint George Wimbly son: and wife
John Executors of this my last will and Tes-
-tament and I do hereby disannul every other
former Will and Testament and do Ratify
and confirm this my last will and Testament
