Six Weeks old was put under the Care of one James Hunt & Mary his Wife then living
about two Miles from W^m Stephen Bryans Iron Works in Baltimore County
in Maryland and his heirs, but in Case my said son should be dead, then I bequeath
the same to my Brother Robert Charles, and my Sister Betty now late in the City of London
in the Kingdom of England to be equally divided amongst them, Share & Share
alike, and to the Survivors or Survivors of them and the Heirs of such Survivor
And I desire that my Executors hereafter named may immediately after my
decease make Sale of what Estate I am possessed with and after paying my just
Debts as aforesaid to apply the Remainder as bequeathed, and I do hereby Constitute and
appoint Richard Fear, John Godloe, and Richard Bart. Executors of this my last Will and
Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made and declaring this to be my last
Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and affixed
my Seal the Day of February in the year one thousand seven hundred and Eighty four
