& State N^o Carolina This fourth day of March one Thousand Seven hundred & Ninety
Eight make & ordain This my last Will & Testament revoking & Disannulling
all other Wills heretofore **made** by me in manner & form following. To wit
I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, praying for his Mercies thro
the merits of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ and my body to be buried at the
discretion of my Executors hereafter named. . . I then I bequeath unto my wife
Elizabeth Garbrough my plantation & all my Lands & all the residue of my
Estate Except what I shall hereafter Give away during her natural life or widowhood
I then I give unto my Daughter Mary Lyal five Shillings my will & desire is that
when the money that Robert Jey is owing me becomes due that my Executors
collect from him the said Jey & Give unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Howards
Lyal fifty Dollars and Give unto my Daughter Winny Jones thirty five Dollars
to them & their heirs forever and the balance of P^r Money after paying all my
Just Debts. I give unto my wife Elizabeth to enable her to maintain my Children
I then I give unto my Daughter Winny Jones one Cow & half to her & her heirs forever
I then after the death or intermarriage of my wife Elizabeth I give all my lands
unto my Son to wit Samuel Hill & his heirs forever.

Collect from him the said sum & Give unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Howson
Lyals fifth Dollar and Give unto my Daughter Winney Jones thirty five dollar
to them & their heirs forever and the balance of I. Money after paying all my
Just Debts. I Give unto my wife Elizabeth to enable her to maintain my Children
Them I Give unto my Daughter Winney Jones one Cow & Hay to her & her heirs forever
Them. After the death or intermarriage of my wife Elizabeth I Give all my lands
unto my Sons to wit. Samuel William George James Moses to be Equally
Divided among them ^{to them} & their heirs forever. All my personal Estate including
the residue of my Estate after the death or intermarriage of my wife Elizabeth
I Give unto my above mentioned Sons & unto my Daughter Tabitha Garbrough
to be Equally Divided among them to Share & Share alike to them & their heirs
forever. It is my Will that my executors sell my Bay mare I purchased of the late
Samuel Howland to help to pay my debts. And Lastly I do constitute &
appoint my wife Elizabeth Garbrough my Friend James Carter & John Smith
Executors & Executors of this my Last Will & Testament: as witness I do hereunto
