do hereby make & ordain This my last Will & Testament revoking & Disannulling
all other Wills heretofore made by me in manner & form following to wit

I commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, praying for his Mercies
the merits of my blessed Saviour Jesus Christ and my body to be buried at the
discretion of my Executors hereafter named

Item I lend unto my wife
Elizabeth Yarborough my plantation & all my Lands & all the residue of my
Estate Except what I shall hereafter Give away during her natural life or widowhood

Item I give unto my Daughter Mary Lyal five Pounds my will & desire is that
when the money that Robert Jey is owing me becomes due that my Executors
collect from him the said sum & Give unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Howards

Lyal fifty Dollars and Give unto my Daughter Winney Jones thirty five Dollars
to them & their heirs forever and the balance of my Money after paying all my
Just Debts I give unto my wife Elizabeth to enable her to maintain my Children

Item I give unto my Daughter Winney Jones one Cow & half to her & her heirs forever
Item after the death or intermarriage of my wife Elizabeth I give all my lands
unto my Sons to wit Samuel Hill & John Hill

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fourth day of March one thousand seven hundred & Thirteen

Twenty five Dollars and Give unto my Daughter Winney Jones thirty five Dollars
to them & their heirs forever and the balance of ~~the~~ money after paying all my
Just Debts. I give unto my wife Elizabeth to enable her to maintain my Children
Them I give unto my Daughter Winney Jones one Cow & Hay to her & her heirs forever
Them. After the death or intermarriage of my wife Elizabeth I give all my lands
unto my Sons to wits. Samuel William George James Moses to be equally
Divided among them ^{to them} & their heirs forever: All my personal Estate including
the residue of my Estate after the death or intermarriage of my wife Elizabeth
I give unto my above mentioned Sons & unto my Daughter Tabitha Garbrough
to be equally divided among them to Share & Share alike to them & their heirs
forever. It is my will that my son John my Bay man purchase of the estate
Samuel Howson due to help to pay my debts: And Lastly I do constitute &
appoint my wife Elizabeth Garbrough my Friend James Carter & John Smith
Executors & Executors of this my Last will & Testament: as witness I do hereunto

 In the Name of God Amen Wm Richardson
 of the County of State aforesaid being weak in Body but in perfect mind & memory thanks
 be to God for the same Do ordain this to be my last will & Testament in manner &
 form following to wit: First of all I recommend my Soul in the hands of God
 & as for my body I desire it to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion
 of my Executors to whom I shall appoint & as for my worldly Estate I desire of
 it in the following Manner First I desire that my Son Elijah Richardson shall
 have my house & plantation Six years & after Six years I desire that my Son Matthew
 Richardson shall have my ~~land~~ plantation: Then I give to my Son Henry
 Richardson one Bay Horse one hundred acres of Land house & plantation situated
 to my Daughter Mourning Bay an acres of Land lying
