 health and sound memory do make and Ordain this to be my last will and
 Testament. Item I give and bequeath to my Brother Frederick Davis the Interest
 in the Negroes that he sold to me which would have been coming to him at my
 Mother's Decease. Item I give and bequeath to Arch^d Davis eldest Son of Fred^d.
 Davis to him his heirs and assigns for ever the lands I bought of Ned Rust or son
 in Franklin County containing one Thousand and ten acres, more less also
 the Interest in the Negroes that will be coming to me at my Mother's Decease
 Item I give and bequeath to my three brothers Dolphin Davis Thomas Davis
 and Archibald Davis to them their heirs and assigns for ever one Thousand acres
 in Franklin County in the State of Georgia which land I bought of George
 Ogg also three Negroes (to wit) Harry, Isaac & Morris to be equally Divided
 between them Item all the rest of my property of every Nature and Kind whatever
 I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Davis to her heirs and assigns for
 ever. Lastly I do appoint my beloved wife Mary Davis Executrix my brother
 Thomas Davis Ex^r. And my brother Archibald Davis Ex^r to this my last will
 and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
 Eleventh day of May Anno Dom 1792

The will of Goodorum Davis Decd was exhibited for probate and it being
proved on Oath that it was found after the death of the said Goodorum amongst
his Valuable papers and it being also proved, by three Credible Witnesses
that they Verily believe the Name of the Goodorum Davis subscribed
thereto to be in his own proper hand writing and also that the said will &
every part thereof is in the proper hand writing of him the said Good-
orum except the words "And my Brother Archibald Davis &c." in which
therein and it further proved by the Oath of Robert Johnston a subscribing Witness
thereto that on the 30th day of September 1808 the said Goodorum requested him the
the said Robert to add the said Archibald Davis as an executor to the said will
and he the said Robert did so by the said distribution instead of doing by
separate and distinct Indentures and at the request of the said Goodorum and in
his presence subscribed thereto as a Witness, he the said Goodorum publishing and
declaring that the said will to be his last will and testament and that the said
Goodorum then was of sound mind and disposing memory and of full age and
to be recorded whereupon Mary Davis the executrix therein named in open Court
and was qualified there to
