God to bestow I give and Bequeath as follows.
I Give and Bequeath to my son Ephraim Emory ^{being} Min-
= ty Acres of Land adjoining the Land whereon I now live
= being one half of one Hundred and Eighty Acres of Land
which I Bought of Nathaniel Johnson it being all between a
creek ^{called the fork of the creek} and the head of the Branch to W^m Cartwright
I Give ^{to my son Ephraim Emory} my Cow and Calf
and one Feather Bed and one Gun. Item I
Give and Bequeath to my son John Emory ^{being} thirty Acres
of Land it being the remaining part of the Hundred and
Eighty Acres before mentioned and all on the lower
side of the above said Branch called the lower branch
and so running from the head of the said Branch to
Cartwright I likewise Give my said son John Emory
one Cow and Calf and one Feather Bed. Item I Give and
Bequeath to my daughter Mary Emory one Cow and
Calf. Item I Give and Bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth
one Cow and Calf. Item I Give and Bequeath to

my daughter Lucy Every one Cow and Calf Item I Give
 and Bequeath to my daughter Leby Every one Cow and
 Calf Item I give and Bequeath to my daughter
 Martha Every one Cow and Calf Item I Give and
 Bequeath to my son Edmund Every one Cow and
 Calf and One Heated Bed Item I send to my well
 Beloved wife Sarah Every all the Best of my My Most
 -able Estate in General with the Plantation where on
 I now live during her widowhood and if she
 never marry again, after my decease during her Natural
 Life and after her decease the said Land and
 Plantation to Return to my aforesaid son Edmund
 Every and all the Mostable Estate to be Equally
 divided amongst all my aforesaid Children and to
 constitute and appoint my well beloved wife Sarah Every
 her and sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament
 and I doe here by Revoke Revoke and make void
 all former wills by me heretofore made or spoken
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 affixed my seal this 14th day of May 1763
