I give unto all my love Book & all my debts due to me upon consideration
she pay all my just debts & easel of my Sons w't shall be living when
they come to age one good feather Bed & furniture & three good Calfs
Calfs, to each of them or in the time there up off fifteen pounds prce money
to paid to each of them also I lend the sum of £1000 to my Wife
Lubitha during her natural life or Item I give & bequeath to my old son
Burke hope, the plantation lying in Barbadoes containing two hundred
& nine acres of Land which fell to me by Marriage, from Banbury McKenney
& also one negroe girl named Pratt, to him his wife & assigns forever
Item I give & bequeath to my four younger Sons, Willm hope, John hope,
Henry Austin hope, & Miles hope & speak first of my Son Willm hope
husk not bequeathed before, to him & their wife & assigns for ever, to be
equally divided to both by John Bradford Jesse hope, & William Lancer
either one of them, & I also appoint John Bradford, Jesse hope & my
well beloved Wife Lubitha, Master & sole Executrix of this my last Will & Settlement
& likewise I appoint the same three persons above Sole Guardians to all
my Children, for witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal

have not bequeathed before, to them & their wife & assigns for ever, to be
equally divided to them by John Bradfod, George hope, & William Lance
either one of them, & I also appoint John Bradford, George hope & my
well beloved wife Laththa, Master & sole Ex^r of this my last Will & Testament
& likewise I appoint the same three persons aboves sole Guardians, & all
my children, for Wm & his wife I have heirents setting hand & seal
