that My Executors should sell such property at public or private Sale
as they shall think best and after my debts are paid it is My desire that
My beloved wife Perry Dickson should have the rest of my property to
raise my Child upon or Children and that she should enjoy it during her
Natural life and after her decease it is My desire My Child or Children
should have my property which I lend to My beloved wife and now I do
solely appoint My friends My Executors George Lottuffer Charles Edwards
Matthew Smith Benjamin Perkins and I do acknowledge this to be My
last will and Testament in witness whereof I have signed set My hand
and Seal this 11th day of September 1867
