son Henry tell he shall arrive at Age I give & Bequeath
to my eldest son Peter three hundred and fifty acres of
Land lying the State of Virginia Mayguffins property bulging
on the South side Chautauque Creek to give his heirs & assigns
for ever I give one hundred acres of Land lying and
adjoining to the upper end of my son Peter's land as
mentioned to be sold at Publick Sale and the money there
arising to be equally divided between my wife and
three children I give and Bequeath to my son
Peter my Negro man Tom to him his heirs and assigns
for ever I give and Bequeath to my son Peter
two cows and one feather Bed and furniture and
my Bay horse Colt Branded with a Cross and my smooth
Hired gun to him and his heirs and assigns for ever
I give and Bequeath to my daughter Susan the Land and
Plantation whereon I live to her heirs and assigns for ever
I give and Bequeath to my daughter Susan my
Negro woman Phillis to her her heirs and assigns for
ever I give and Bequeath to my son Henry my Plan-
tation lying on the South side of Musch Island Creek
to him his heirs and assigns for ever I give
and Bequeath to my son Henry my Negro
Boy Dick to him his heirs and assigns for ever
I give and Bequeath to my son Henry two cows
and my Hired gun to him his heirs and assigns for
ever I give and Bequeath to my son Henry the feather
Bed and furniture to him his heirs for ever I do
nominate and appoint my Brother Peter Robertson
to execute this my last Will and Testament hereby
revoking all former Wills by me made in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
twenty Eighth day of May one thousand seven hundred
and eighty three
