and form following In witness my will and desire is

during her widowhood or natural life provided she  
Shall take care to Raise and Maintain my youngest  
son Henry till he shall arrive at Age of twenty five years  
to my Eldest son Peter three hundred and fifty acres of  
Land lying the Plan of Phariah May off the Dapphies running  
on the Middle side Chaukent Creek to which his heirs and assigns  
for ever I leave one hundred acres of Land lying land  
adjoining to the upper end of my son Peters land app-  
Mentioned to be sold at Publick Sale and the money thereon  
equally divided between my wife and  
the children I give and bequeath to my son  
Peter my negro man Tom to him his heirs and assigns  
for ever I give and bequeath to my son Peter  
two cows and one leather Bed and furniture and  
my Bay horse Colly Branded with a Cross and two smooth  
hairs given to him and his heirs and assigns for ever  
I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy the land and  
plantation whereon her late husband lies and assigns for ever  
I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy my  
negro woman Phillis to her heirs and assigns for  
ever I give and bequeath to my son Henry my Plan-  
tation lying on the south side of Brush Dolands Creek  
to him his heirs and assigns for ever I give and  
bequeath to my son Henry my negro  
boy Dick to him his heirs and assigns for ever  
I give and bequeath to my son Henry two cows

son Henry till he shall arrive at age of ten I give & Bequeath  
to my Eldest son Peter three hundred and fifty acres of  
land being the Plan & Prairie May 1st of this year lying  
on the North side Chautauk Creek to him his heirs and assigns  
for Eric Stem I leave one hundred acres of land lying and  
adjoining to the upper end of my son Peters lands above  
mention'd to be sold at Publick Sale and the money therefrom  
arising to be equally divided between my wife and  
three children Stem I give and Bequeath to my son  
Peter my Negro man John to him his heirs and assigns  
for Eric Stem I give and Bequeath to my son Peter  
two cows and the foal her Bed and furniture and  
my Gray mare colt branded with a Cross and any smooth  
hayed grass to him and his heirs and assigns for Eric  
Stem I give and Bequeath to my daughter Lucy the land and  
plantation whereon I now live & her heirs and assigns for Eric  
Stem I give and Bequeath to my Negro  
Negro woman Phyllis to her her heirs and assigns for  
Eric I give and Bequeath to my son Henry the Plant-  
ation lying on the south side of Rush Dolphus Creek  
to him his heirs and assigns for Eric Stem I  
give and Bequeath to my son Henry my Negro  
boy Dick to him his heirs and assigns for Eric  
Stem I give and Bequeath to my son Henry two cows  
and my stiled plantation his heirs and assigns for  
Eric Stem I give and Bequeath to my son Henry the feather  
Bed and furniture to him his heirs for Eric ~~that~~ I  
nominate and appoint my Brother Peter Robertson  
to execute this my last Will and Testament hereby  
done at King all former Wills by me made in Wimberly  
whereof I have no note at present and recall this  
writting English day of May the thousand seven hundred  
and sixties three

this my last will and Testament that is to say first and  
firstest I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty  
Who gave it me and my Body to the Earth to be Honourably Buried  
after the direction of My Executors hereof as aforesaid  
My will and desire is that all my debts and funeral expences  
be paid and discharged and as for the Rest and  
Beside of what mortallie Goods it shall please Almighty  
to God to bestow I give and Begyneth as follows  
Item I give and Begyneth to my son Ephraim <sup>my</sup> three  
Acres of Land adijining the Land whereon I now dwelle  
one half of one hundred and Eighty acres affad  
which I bought of Purchas Johnson it lies all betweene  
called the South Branch of the River of the same  
a straight course from the Head of the Brook to W<sup>m</sup> Cutts line  
I give to my son Ephraim <sup>my</sup> Cow and Calf  
and the Scatter Bed and one Cow I term  
Gill
