3^d I have unto Phillis W. West my beloved wife, all the Remainder of my Land that I possess lying in the County & State aforesaid not yet mentioned during my natural life & after her Death I give and bequeath the Land last above mentioned unto my Sister Elizabeth Daniel's Children to be divided between them and their heirs alike to them and their heirs for ever.

My will & desire is that my Executors hereafter mentioned shall sell and dispose of as they think proper, at least I have of Land lying in Isle of Wight County State of Virginia containing Fifty Acres be the same more or less which I am hereby bound for to compel him to make a title to when he shall see the money arising from the sale thereof is for the payment of my just debts & if there should not be a sufficiency from the sale of the Land my wish is that a sufficiency of money may be raised out of the residue of my Estate not yet mentioned.

4th I give unto my beloved wife Phillis W. West after my just debts are paid out of the residue of my Estate not yet mentioned of any so many kind seems to her
