I Give & bequeath to my Son Richard Moore one Negro Woman named Pleasant, one Negro Boy named Withe, to him & his Heirs for ever.

I Give & bequeath to my son Elijah Moore five Shillings Sterling. And lastly I do appoint my beloved Wife Ann Moore, and my Friends Richard Norwood & Alexander Love Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have unto set my hand and Seal this 30th day of December, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty eight.
