First I bequeath to my beloved wife Milla Qualls, my whole Estate consisting of lands negroes &c for to support herself & my son Alfred Qualls during her lifetime; then I give & bequeath to my above mentioned son Alfred Qualls, all my lands, plantations negroes with all my other property or estate, to him, & his heirs for ever; but if the said son should die without heir, then it is my will & desire that my wife Milla Qualls should have a comfortable maintenance out of my Estate during her life & in that case, my whole Estate above mentioned I give to my Brother Peter Qualls him his heirs forever. My desire is that my son may be brought up in a religious manner, with proper Education, at the discretion of my said wife Milla Qualls; and I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved friends Isaac Nick & Benjamin Teller Executors to this my last Will & Testament & I do hereby disannul & make void all other wills by me made relating & confirming this to be my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 25th day of November 1796
