sound mind & of sound memory thankes to Almighty God do this third
day of January in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and eighty two make & declare this my last Will and Testament in
which I recommend my soul to Almighty God in hope of a Remis-
sion of my sins that the Meats and Drufflings of our Blessed Lord
and Saviour Jesus Christ. and as to all worldly Tattle with hark
Pleased God to enlent me unto I give and Bequeath in man-
ner and form following to Kit, Henr. I lend to my former wife
Frances. I will during her life or widowhood the land nowhere
on this Negros Cease and Dis, two White Mares, to Kit, Bonny
and Jemmy, half the Black Cattle. Hogg and Sheep I am Possess
of ten peckabells & furniture, one Brandy Still, Worm & Lick,
two Iron Potts, one Bass Nettle, one halfe the Barn the Barn
open, one large Pine Chest, six Chairs, two pipes for horses, six
horses & mts, one fijingsom, one Butter Pot, one Case of
Bottles, one Brandy afford drawing Knives, side saddle and
Bidle one Plough & Plough-hire & all the other Lugges & Poultry
on the Plantation where I now live. Item. I give to my said
wife Frances one Negro girl called Aggy, one Black Walnut Tree
all the spinning wheels & Cards, so East about & heale the weyng,
Fender, Item, a girl and Bequeath unto James Smith son of
John Smith the said John wife, or to Kit Bass Stelle after the death
or marriage of my said wife, to him. Hires & Assigns for ever
Item, I Give and Bequeath unto the said John Smith son
James Smith one Negro woman called Rachael, one gun with
the Gunstock Muzzle, and the Bed wherein she will lie a Bed
Rugge to him his Hires and Assigns. Item I give and Bequeath
unto James Smith son of John Smith one Sattell and
Furniture, one Bed and place with a saddle and Bridle him
and his assigns for ever, Item I Give unto the s. James Smith
the new Gun and Brandy Still Worm and Lick after the death

over and from following to fit, Item I leave to my loving wife
Frances Smith during her life or widowhood all land & knowlde
or two Negros Cesar and this, two White Mares, to fit, Bonny
and Jester, half the Black Cattle, Hogs and Sheep I am possessed
of two featherbeds & furniture, one Brandy Still, Worm & Salt,
one Iron Potts, one Brass Kettle, one half the Drifts the few
gun, one large Pine Chest, six Chairs, four Tops from trees, six
Pines & firs, one spinning wheel, one Butter Pot, one Case of
Butter, one Bridal affore drawing knife, one saddle and
Bridle one wrought Plough-hire & all the geese, Turkeys & Poultry
on the Plantation where I now live. Item I give to my said
wife Frances one Negro girl called Abby, one Black Walnut Kettle
all the spinning wheels & Cards, six Cart wheels & their axles
four axle, Item, a girl and Beguileth wife James Smith son of
John Smith the said John Smith son to wife Frances Smith after the death
or Marriage of my said wife, to her, Item I give & Assign for ever
Item, a Girl and Beguileth unto the said John Smith son
James Smith one Negro woman called Rachel, one Gun with
a Scumput Muzzle, and the Bed wherein she will sleep
Abby whom his wife and designs. Item I give said Beguileth
to John Smith & will son of John Smith one Scotlandard
Furniture, one bed made three with a saddle and Bridle him
and his assigns for ever, Item I give unto the said James Smith
the new Gun and Brandy Still now and back after the death
or Marriage of my said wife one fourth part of the Plantation
Item, I give to Henry Johnson wife of James Johnson one
Negro girl called Mary, Item, I give to James Killingsworth
son of William Killingsworth a Negro girl called Rose, up to the
death or marriage of my said wife, Item, I give and Beguileth
to the Sarah Sparrow, wife of John Sparrow one Negro man
and boy, to her, her wife and assigns for ever, Item I give and
Assign Beguileth Henry son of my good wife after her death
or marriage of the aforesaid & her husband, Item, I give the aforesaid

the said Rebecca Burley wife of John Smith her husband, one floor
and I count and one iron Skillet to her use heirs and assigns,
Item, I give unto James Smith son of John Smith after the
decease or marriage of my said Wife Frances my Negro
Man called Caesar and the great tooling place, Item, I desire
that my Wife & her Family may be supported with sufficient
Provisions to the finishing of my life, that is that she
shall have one board mett for her Family and Working pur-
poses, and also to raise a sufficient number of negroes to support
the Family the ensuing year, Item, I give unto the Sons
and Daughters of William Smith deceased sole of Newkemp
one fifteenth pounds each to them and their heirs, Item, all
the West and Residue of my Estate I give unto Anna Norwood
Daughter of Samuel Norwood & Butterfield Elizabeth Bradford
to be equally divided share and share alike to them their
heirs and assigns forever, And lastly I appoint my
loving Wife and James Smith son of John Smith Exe^rcutor
of this my last Will and Testament, James E. Smith Esq^r
Signed Sealed Published and Declared to be his last Will and
Testament, Haniel Wall, Samuel Wall his mate, Eliza
Burke, his mate.

Halifax for June Court 1762.

This Will was exhibited in open Court and attested by the Esq^r,
and duly Proved by the oath of Daniel Wall one of the Subscribing
Witnesses thereto, who in his oath did say he saw the said Haniel
Wall, and Elizabeth Burke the other two Subscribing
Witnesses sign this Will as Witnesses; whereupon Francis
Smith Esq^r and James Smith Esq^r, in the Will named
was duly Qualify'd by taking the Oath by Law prescribed
and so ordered the Will recorded List, Jno. Mungo Esq^r.
