In the name of God amen I John Turner of the County of Halifax & State of North Carolina
being sick & weak of Body but of perfect mind & memory & calling to mind the mortality of man
Body & knowing that all flesh must yield to death when God is pleased to call I do by these
presents make & ordain this to be my last will & Testament, Give my soul to God
that gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian form & touching my
worldly goods I shall dispose of in form following
Item I lend unto my well beloved wife Phoebe Turner the Land & plantation whereon I now
live during her natural life provided that Uzaiah Footgood do make & execute a lawful right
& title to the said Phoebe Turner & after her decease the said Land to be sold as other property
Item I also lend to my well beloved wife Phoebe Turner during her natural life my negro
to wit Pompey, bot. abt. sixty neg. Miles Nan Charity with her decease to be sold & equally
divided between all my children if living if not to their heirs also I lend to my well beloved wife
Phoebe Turner during her natural life my stock of all kind with all other property
first Reserving as much property to be sold as will satisfy my debts due & demand, the residue
after her decease to be sold & equally divided between all my children or their heirs as before
mentioned Be it known & Remembered that my desire is that my children under law, sub

age should be & remain together with their Mother & be maintained & supported until they come of lawful age or Marriages. I do by these presents appoint my wife Phoebe Turner Samuel Hodgson & Samuel Gainer to be full & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament & do hereby make null & void all & every will or Wills heretofore by me made: Notwithstanding this & no other to be my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 29th November 1795
