in manner & form following. In witness whereof I will & desire that all my just debts be paid by my Executors
hereafter mentioned. Item, I give & bequeath unto my loving Wife Mary Gilmore of London in the
Kingdom of Great Britain the sum of One thousand dollars to be paid by my Executors, as soon
as it can be raised out of my Estate. Item, I will & desire that the sum of One hundred Dollars be
annually be allowed unto my Youngest Son Henry Charles Gilmore of North Carolina for his main-
tenance & Support, during his Minority. Item, I give & bequeath to my loving Nephew William Gilmore
of North Carolina the sum of one hundred pounds Virginia Money to be raised out of my Estate.
Item, I give & bequeath unto my two Sons John Allan Gilmore of London in the Kingdom of
Great Britain, & Henry Charles Gilmore of North Carolina all the residue of my estate
real & Personal, which I am possessed of after paying my just debts & Legacies to be equally
divided between them when my Youngest Son Henry Charles Gilmore shall arrive to the age of twenty
one years. And lastly I do nominate, constitute & appoint my Nephew William Gilmore
Esquire of North Carolina my whole & sole Executor to this my last Will & Testament, hereby con-
firming all formerly Wills by me heretofore made, with full power to sell & dispose of any part of my estate real
or Personal to pay the said debts & Legacies &c. &c. &c. In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand
& affixed my seal, this second day of December, in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
& Ninety two
