Lands, arming unto me & all Titles of Lands, by me at any time
made, whatsoever or wheresoever same may be, to be by him sold
to the best Advantage, with full power to him to make
sufficient Conveyances of same little purchasers & the money
arising there from, to gather with what may arise of my all other
my personal Estate or debts due to me heretofore I hereby
will & desire, may be applied in the first place to the discharging
all my just debts, & the surplus I give & bequeath unto,
the sd Joseph Montfort & his heirs & executors forever, & I do
hereby constitute & appoint the sd Joseph Montfort my whole &
sole & regular of this my last Will & Testament, In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal, this eighteenth day of August
1764 Jno Sinton Seal signed sealed published &
declared by the sd John Sinton to be his last Will & Testament in
the presence of us Benjamin McCullough & Harriet Stokes John
