do make this my last Will and Testament in Manner and Form
following that is to say, I impress my Will and desire is yet all
my just debts and funeral expenses ~~done~~^{paid} & just debts
satisfied, and I charge on my estate to pay the payment thereof -
Item I leave to my loving wife Mary Harris, after paying my
just debts and funeral expenses before mentioned, all the
remainder of my estate both real and personal, whereon or wheretoever
is or shall be at the time of my decease found during the term of
her natural life, and of worth a bed after her decease, then give
to equitable division to my four legitimate Mary Harris, & the Child
& Children with whose surviving wife is now pregnant, to be equally
divided among them Share & Share alike, to the survivor or survivors
of them & the heirs of such survivor, & of this my Will
constitute a valid & perfect enloring of wife Mary Harris
and John Grubbs Green my Executor, hereby revoking
all former Wills before made, and declaring this to be my
last Will and Testament, in witness whereof I the said
John Harris have begone at S. J. Has. & signed affixed my Seal
this twelfth day of February in the year of our Lord 1764
John Harris ^{Sub C.} Signed sealed published and declared, by
the Testator as and for his last Will and Testament in the
presence of us, whereat his Request subscribed our Names as
Witnesses to the due Execution of the same testator further
Mary Harris has signed Richard Spear
