And Testament, that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the
 Hands of almighty God, that gaver, and my Body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in,
 decent Christian Burial, at the discretion of my Executor nothing doubting, but at the general
 resurrection, I shall receive, the same again by the mighty power God and as touching such
 worldly Estate, wherewith it has pleased God, to bless me with in this life, I give devise & dispose
 of the same in the following Manner & form -

First. Item I give & bequeath to Lucy my beloved
 wife, my negroe man George to Dispose of as may please her, in a manner whatsoever, as
 also, I lend to my beloved wife the use of all my other Lands, & Tenements Goods & Chattles
 excepting two negroes, to wit, a negroe Girl, named Lucy and one named Chaimy all other of
 my Estate of whatsoever kind it be Excepting four feather Beds & their furniture, I lend to my
 aforaid Loving wife. so Long as she may Live and at her death to be Equally divided among
 all my Children Share & Share equal alike and if any of my Children should die before
 the division of My Estate, my will & desire is that their Children, should have a Childs part
 among them.

Item I give & bequeath to my Loving Daughter Zilpha My negroe
 Girl Lucy & two feather Beds & furniture to her & her heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath to my Loving Daughter Bithia one negroe Girl named Chaimy
 and two feather Beds & furniture to her & her heirs for & all other of my Estate after the
 decease of my wife, I desire may Equally be divided amongst Each & every of one of my
 Children namely Nathaniel Hauer Mary Johnston Hilda Newson Elizabeth Wright
 Barbara Welton Zilpha Rooper & Bithia Rooper,

Children namely Nathaniel Haws, Mary Johnston Hulca Neuse, Elizabeth Wright,
Barbara Wilson Zephia Rooper & Bethia Rooper,

I Now constitute & appoint my loving wife Lucy Executrix of this my last will & Testament & also Ordain & appoint Col. Willis Abston, William Pryor & Henry Hyde the whole & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament and I do hereby utterly revoke & disannul all other & former wills, testaments & bequests whatsoever, by me before named making & confirming this & this only to be my last will & Testament & none other, It is also my will & desire, that my Executors, might if they shall see Cause sell & dispose with the consent of My wife any part of My stock or other Estate as may be thought Good & the Money so arising to be converted, to the use of my said wife, or to be Equally divided amongst all my Children. Finally, the Estate herein before lent to my loving wife - all money due to my Estate to be by my Executors Collected and all just debts paid, and I hereby as before mentioned ratify & confirm this my last will & Testament, In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 14th day of May in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven and ninety four
