Kitchen furniture two Pewter Pies two sets two Wedding Hoses one Spooling Box
one 2013

the big one pair fine Tongue on P. S. and two one Wooden Bone Lemon white. Two
pair Stockings one half stockings I have Cow hide to remain together unless by misfortune
or bad conduct it be likely to waste in that case my desire is that it be sold
and divided equally among them as above mentioned. Then I give to my
youngster Stephen Williamson one Negro Girl by the name of Sarah to her and
her heirs forever, my will and desire is that all my property not herein given
away should by the direction of my Executors Stanley mentioned be sold
and the money arising from the sale after paying my just debts shall be equally
divided as in the case aforesaid among my wife Joshua and my children
my wife in the case above during her life or widowhood or natural life and after
her death or intermarriage the sum to be divided as among the children to
viz Stephen, Harry, Judith Williamson & Anna Williamson the last of which to
them & their heirs forever; last of all nominate & appoint my Friend and Brother
Joshua Williamson my whole sole Executor to this my late will and Testamento
marking and cancelling all other wills or wills by me made acknowledging this
to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I do set my hand & seal
