one pig one pair fine hogs one p. saw horse one wooden saw horse white two
p. horses one steel saddle I have Cow hide to remain together unless by misfortune
or bad conduct it be like to waste in that case my desire is that it be sold
and divided equally among them as above mentioned. Then I give to my
daughter Milbry Williamson one Negro Girl by the name of Sarah to her and
her heirs forever, My will and desire is that all my property not herein given
away should by the discretion of my Executors lastly mentioned be sold
and the money arising from the sale after paying my just debts shall be equally
divided as in the case aforesaid among my wife Milbry and my children
my wife in the case above during her life and her heirs or natural life and after
her death or intermarriage not yet to be divided are among the children to
wit Stephen, Henry, Burdell Milbry & James Williamson the whole of which to
them I thus give, Last of all I nominate & appoint my Friend and Brother
Joshua Williamson my whole sole Executor to this my last will and Testament
touching and concerning all other wills or wills by me made acknowledging this
to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I do set my hand at
this 28th day February in the year Our Lord 1800—
