Blessed Saviour Jesus Christ and my Body to the Earth to be buried according
to the direction of my Executors hereafter named First I that all my worldly
debts be fully satisfied and paid — Then I give and bequeath unto my beloved
daughter Elizabeth Harris one negro fellow called Bob. Also one bay horse
called Buck and if my daughter should depart this life without her law-
fully begotten of her Body my will & desire is that negro fellow Bob & horse
before mentioned should remain to my daughter Anne Daniel to her & her heirs for-
ever — Then I give unto my beloved daughter Sally Cox one bed & furniture
to her and her heirs forever — Then I give unto my ^{beloved} daughter Prudence Hurt
one Bed & Furniture one sorrel horse called Barbary to her and her heirs for-
ever — Then I give unto my beloved daughter Anne Daniel the following negroes
to wit: Tim, Eliza, Myrmie, Rhoda, Miram, Tim, Richmon, Conner, Loba, Poll, Pegg
to her during her natural life and my will & desire is that after my before
mentioned Anne Daniels death that the above named negroes, Tim, Eliza, Myrmie
Rhoda, Miram, Tim, Richmon, Conner, Loba, Poll, Pegg shall go to my Grand-
Grand daughter Sarah Dawson Jones. I shall have one negro Girl named Gennie
and one negro Girl named Loba and if my granddaughter dies without and
lawfully begotten of her Body that then the before named negroes

to return to her surviving Brothers and their heirs forever Also my will &
desire is that my Grandson Joseph John Daniel shall have a negro man named
Tom, from negro woman named Myrma to him & his heirs forever and also
that Polly Daniel shall have two negroes Eliza & Miron to her and her heirs
✓ forever Also that Robert Brinkley Daniel shall have two negroes to wit Tom and
Rhoda, to him and his heirs forever and also that William Henry Daniel shall

my will & desire is that my Granddaughter Elizabeth Holt shall have one negro girl
named Pige after the death of my daughter Anne Daniel to her and her heirs for

Jr. one negro man named Quob and one feather bed to him & his heirs forever
Then I give unto my Granddaughter Sally Brinkley the daughter of Robert Brinkley
Jr. one feather bed to her and her heirs forever — Then I give and bequeath

Holt one Bed & Furniture to her and her heirs forever — Then I constitute and appoint
my well beloved friends Archibald Daniel and Lewis Daniel Jrs. Read my Executors

In the Name of God Amen, I Robert Hall of the County of Halifax and State of North Carolina being very weak in Body but of perfect sound mind and memory do make and Ordain this to be my last Will and Testament as follows I give to my wife one feather bed and furniture, one Chest, three Chairs, one pine Table, two pots, one dish, one Basin, 5 plates, one flat Iron, six barrels Corn, four hundred Weight of Pork one spinning wheel & cards, to her during her Widowhood the balance of my Estate after all debts are paid to be equally divided between my two sons David & Burgess to them & their heirs forever, I hereby appoint my sons David & Burgess Executors to this my last Will & Testament, I leave to Charlotte Hall one Shilling Henry Hall one Shilling Hartwell Hall one Shilling In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 11th day of September 1799—
