Nichols all my whole Estate real & personal, during her natural Life, but after the death of my wife it is my will that all my whole Estate, shall be sold & divided amongst. Solomon Turner (Heir) his Daughter. Mary having a Double portion amongst his Children. To wit, Barabas Turner, John Turner. Susannah Turner.

Item, I give & bequeath to my Brother James. Nichols, ten pounds to be paid out of my Estate by my Executors -

Item, I give & bequeath to my Sister John Samuel Higgs. Ten pounds to be paid by my
Executors. Lastly - I Constitute nominate & appoint my Wife Susannah Nichols, Samuel
Higgs Executors of this my last Will & Testament. touching, revoking, annulling & making void
all former Wills heretofore by me made I declare this to be my last will & Testament -
