In The Name of God Amen I Marmande Bell of Halifax County & State of North Carolina being weak of Body but of sound mind & memory do make & ordain this my last will & Testament in the following manner first I recommend my Body to the Earth & myself to the hand of Almighty God that Gave it, & as to my worldly Estate I leave in the following manner Item I give to my loving wife Martha Bell, four negroes Frank Tom Dru & Cate also my stock of Cattle & Sheep & Hogs, three head of Horses, Bollar the mouse trap Filly & young Black Catt & one third part of the house-holds & Kitchen furniture, as her own property for her to dispose of as she thinks proper, I now send to my loving wife the Lands whereon I now live during her natural life also I send her old Sarah & old Isaac & young Par-

Item I give to my son Benjamin Bell the Land that I possess lying in Scotland Neck joining of Marmande Norfield & James Smith Land, also Give him the Land whereon I now live after the death of my wife. Item I give to my Daughter Millie Bell one Negroe Girl by the name of Puff. I now leave the remaining parts of my Estate to be Equally divided between my two Children Millie Bell & Benjamin Bell after my just debts are paid. Item I now leave the whole of my property to my wife Martha Bell as long as she lives a widow or while my Children comes of age or marry & my will is that my son Benjamin shall have his proper to himself at the age of nineteen years I Now appoint my loving wife Martha & my friend Drew Smith my whole & sole Executors of this my Last Will & Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this day of 1796

Item I give to my son Benjamin Bell the same, that I possess by right in Scotland Neck
Joining of Marmaduke Norfleet & James Smith Land, also Give him the Land wherein
I now live after the death of My Wife. Item I give to my Daughter Miley Bell
one Negroe Girl by the name of Bess. I now leave the remaining part of my Estate
to be Equally divided between my two Children Miley Bell & Benjamin Bell after my
my just debts are paid. Item I now leave the whole of my property to my wife Martha
Bell as long as she lives a widow or while my children comes of age or marry & my will
is that my son Benjamin shall have his proper to himself at the age of nineteen years
I now appoint my loving wife Martha & my friend Brew Smith my sole & sole
Executors of this my Last Will & Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& seal this day of 1796
