Item I Give and Bequeath to my Sister Anne Lattimore  
my Gold Ring and do constitute and appoint Dr  
Benjamin Crooker Executor of my Last Will and  
Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto  
Set my hand and Seal this 3<sup>d</sup> day July 1763
