I Give & Recommend my Soul into the Hand of Almighty God that
Gave it as to my worldly Estate I Give I Give & Bequeath
In Manner & form following —

Now I Give and bequeath all the land & plantation wherein I now
Live to my Two Sons Henry & Thomas Garland to be Equally Divided
Between them to them their Heirs & assigns for Ever
Now I Give to my Daughter Miriam Garland Thirteen Dollars & five
Pence in Hand money —

Now I Give my whole Stock of Cattle to my Two Sons Henry & Thomas
& my Daughter Miriam Garland to be Equally Divided Among them
Now I Give my Daughter Mary Garland two Shillings & six Pence
And all the rest of my Estate Not Mentioned in Legacies Before I Give

Now I give and bequeath all the land & plantation whereon I now
Live to my Two Sons Henry & Thomas Garland to be Equally Divided
Between them to them their Heirs & assigns for Ever
Now I give to my Daughter Miriam Garland Fifteen Dollars & five
Pence in hard money —

Now I give my whole Stock of Cattle to my Two Sons Henry & Thomas
& my Daughter Miriam Garland to be Equally Divided Among them

Now I give my Daughter Mary Garland two Shillings & six Pence
And all the rest of my Estate Not Mentioned in Legacies Before I give
to my Two Sons Henry & Thomas Garland & my Daughter Miriam
Garland to be Equally Divided Among them

Lastly I Appoint my friends Bridgman & Theophilus Jayer Esqrs.
to this my last Will & Testament Hereby Disannulling & Revoking
All Other wills & Testaments by me made & Co ratify & Confirm this
& none Other to be my last will & Testament In witness
