so left (which the said Mary Bruce shall not make under
the power of Forfeiting it the same to the State to the sum whereof
aforesaid I say this my Last Will doth die the sd Estate after
the death of the sd Mary to be equally divided amongst his five
children viz Peter Bruce, Anne Fountain Elizabeth Orton, John
Bruce, Sarah Braenell, Alice Hurl, Item; I desire the said
Estate to be divided amongst the said Inheritors at the dis-
cretion of Peter Bruce and John Braxton Robert Fountain Item;
I do hereby appoint the aforesd Peter Bruce and John Fountain
Sisters to this my Last Will and Testament Item; I do
hereby appoint Peter Bruce and Mary my wife Executrix of
this my Last Will and Testament; I sign'd sealed & acknowledged
by the aforesaid Peter Bruce as his last Will and Testament

Frances Smith during her life or widowhood the land knowne
as two Negros Peaces and this, two White Mares, to wit, Bonny
and Jenny, half the Black Cattle. Hoggas and Sheep I am Possest
of two Peacockes & furniture, one Brandy Still, Wormy tub,
two Iron Potts, one Bass Hettle, one half the Pot in the Room
yours, one large Pine Chest, six Chairs, two Tops from trees, six
Tables & desks, one Frying pan, one Butter Pot, one Case of
Butter, one Pendal affore drawing of my wifes side saddle and
Bidle one Plough & Plough-hire & all the geese Swans & Poultry
on the Plantation where I now live. Item I give to my said
wife Frances one Negro girl called Aggy, one Black Walnut Tree
all the spinning wheels & Cards, a Cart & two Hounds to her & her assigns
for ever, Item I give and Beguirth unto James Smith son of
John Smith the land I now live in & one Bass Hettle after the death
or marriage of my said wife, to him & his & Assigns for ever
Item I give and Beguirth unto the said John Smith son
James Smith one Negro woman called Rosabel, one Gun with
a Lunsford Muzzle, and the Bed wherein I lie with a like
Stagg to him his wife and assigns. Item I give and Beguirth
unto James Smith son of John Smith one Saddle and
Saddle-hire, one bald faced Horse with a saddle and Bridle to him
and his assigns for ever, Item I give and Beguirth unto the said James Smith
the new Gun and Brandy Still from me & back after the death
or marriage of my said wife one Soneth best of the Month

mer said form following to wit, Item I bequeath to my loving wife
Frances Smith during her life or widowhood the land nowhere
over two Negroes Cesar and this, two White Males, to wit, Bonny
and Jerry, half the Black Cattle. Hogs and Sheep I am to be
left of two featherbeds & furniture, one Brandy Still, Worms Lub,
two Iron Potts, one Bass Huttle, one half the Stable the Barn
yarn, one large Pine Chest, six Chairs, two sets of four horses, six
horses & foals, one prancing stallion, one Bedder Sett free Case of
Bettles, one Brandy affore drawing of which side saddle and
Bridle one Plough & Plough-hire & all the gear Luggages & Poultry
on the Plantation where I now live. Item. I give to my said
Wife Frances one Negro girl called Peggy, one Bush Walnut Sett
and the spinning wheels & Cards, & Cart wch the healds & her designs
for ever, Item, I give and Bequeath unto James Smith son of
John Smith the said John Smith die, not and Bass Huttle wch the death
or Marriage of my said wife, to him, & his & Descendents for ever
Item, I give and Bequeath unto the said John Smith son
James Smith one Negro woman called Rachel, one Gun with
a Scrimper Muzzle, and the Bed wherein I lie with a Table
Peggy taken his Gun and designs. Item, I give and Bequeath
unto James Smith son of John Smith one Sattled and
Saddle. one bald faced horse with a saddle and Bridle him
and his designs for ever, Item I give unto the said James Smith
the crew Gun and Powder Still Wm and Licks after the death
or Marriage of my said wife one fourth Part of the Peculiar
Item, I give to the said Frances wife of James Smith free
Negro girl called Ann, Item, I give to James Killings worth
son of William Killings worth a Negro girl called Ann, after the
death or Marriage of my said wife, Item, I give and Bequeath
unto Sarah Sparrow, wife of John Sparrow one Negro woman
and Son, to her, her heirs & descendents for ever, Item, I give and
Bequeath Brandy Plough like of my said wife wch the death or
Marriage of John Sparrow & his wife, Item, I give ~~one~~ unto
