Wills proved at January Court 1765. as follows

The nuncupative Will of Peter Johnson late of Halifax
County decd, made and declared in the presence of Thomas
Price Sarah Price Thomas Price on the 18th day of September
and reduced to Writing on the 26th day of October 1764
following. In Case I die I give and bequeath to my
well beloved eldest Son I intend to call Raymond and his
Heirs all my Estate both real and personal and my
Will and Desire is that he take the same into his Posses-
sion immediately after my decease to his own proper use
and the Use of his other Heirs whatsoever.
