manner. I lend unto my beloved wife Mary Vinson my
land and plantation during her widowhood I further lend her
one bay horse Dumphin one bay mare Pol. four Cows and Yearlings
my stock sheep, two sows and pigs one work steer and all my
beds excepting two which give them two one to Kinay and the
other to Memmoy. I further lend to my wife as much of
my household and kitchen furniture and plantation utensils as
is necessary for her support I further give her as much Corn and
meat as will support her and family one year, and for the
residue of my property I desire all of it to be sold excepting
my still to be disposed in the manner following to wit. I give
my son Peter one year schooling and the residue to be equally
divided among all my children share and share alike
and for the property that I lend to my wife after ^{her} death I desire

and for the property that I leave to my wife after ^{her} Death I desire
my land and all my Property to be sold the land to be sold
on giving two payments the first twelve month Credit and the
last twelve months Credit and the money to be equally divided
amongst all my Children share and share alike I fur
leave my friend Marriott Davis and my son Garret Vison
Executors of my last will and testament abolishing all others
as witness my hand the day and year within written
