God that gave it My Body to be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my
Executors as to my worldly Estate I Give & Bequeath in the manner
and form following.

I now live with all the plantation Tools and Creatures that I don't give in
Legacy to my children and With Every Other article of my Estate of what kind
Soever to her my S^r wife during her life and they the S^r articles of Estate is

and Children as they can best agree.
