do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
in Manner and form following Vizt.

In witness I give good Bequeath the Plantation and Land
whereon I now live to my brother Jordan Pope also the
Plantation and Land I have in the Woods Waller
now lies after the death of Mother in said Plantation
Pryor to him and his heirs forever, but if my said
Brother Jordan should absent his life with out
Leaving I amfull issue of his body then I give and
Bequeath the said Plantations and Lands to my
Brother William Pope and to the heirs of his body
I amfullly Beqotted for ever; I also give and Bequeath
my said Brother Jordan my hand & Cattell my
Stock of hogs and sheep, Geese, & Pigeons & Lamb my
horse Saddle & Tidle & all the Corn, wine Casks & Hopping
trls in my Plantation my Dray of the Cart and Wheels
which are between my Brother William and my self
my bedstead and furniture, my Chest my Wains
Apparell all my household furniture, half my Gook
my debts and ready money and othes, the following
Azel Paying unto his Brother Jord Pope one suit of my
German George Cloath when he shall come to sumfullage
Item I give good Bequeath to my Brother William
Pope my head of Cattle half my Geese & small Chest
Item I give and Bequeath to my Cousin Molly Conell
one Cow and Lamb, and I do hereby Comittelle and
Appoint my said Brother Jordan Pope my sole Executor
to this my last will and Testament Reciting and
Requesting my Neigbor Mr Thomas Hall to assist
and help me till hee be in, and concerning the Premises

Prior to his said his heirs forever, but if my said
Brother Jordan should absent this life with out
Leaving Lawfull Issue of his Body then I Give and
Bequeath the said Probate to my said Sons and
Brother William Pope and to the heirs of his Body
Lawfull Begotten in fact; I also Give and Bequeath
my said Brother Jordan my Head of Cattle my
Sheep of Lambs and sheep, except one Lamb my
horse Saddle & Tidle all the Corn - Sider Casks & Hopping
tubs in my Plantation my Barley the Oats and Sheeps
which are between my brother William and myself
my bedsteads and furniture, my Chest my Writing
Apparrell all my household furniture, half my Stock
my Slaves and Slaves Money and oals, the following
and Paying unto his Brother Joel Pope one suit of my
German George Cloath when he shall arrive to Lawfullage
Item I Give and Bequeath to my Brother William
Pope my head of Cattle half my Cask & small Chest
Item I Give and Bequeath to my Son in Law John Connell
one Cow and Lamb, and I do hereby Constitute and
Appoint my said Brother Jordan Pope my sole Executor
to this my Last Will and Testament Relating and
Requesting my Neigbor Mr Thomas Hall to visit
alltest and Admit him in, and Concerning the Premises
Until he shall arrive to Lawfull age, Is witness whereof
I the said Richard Pope have hereunto set my hand and
seal this twentieth day of April anno Domini 1762

Recorded.
