In the Name of God Amen. I Robert Pasmore of
Halifax County being Sick & weak of Body but in perfect
Sense Mind & Memory Do make & declare this my Last Will
& Testament in Manner & form as follows Viz. —
I give & bequeath to my Eldest Son John One
~~Horse Coll~~
~~Item. I Give to my second son. Housman One Cow & calf~~
Item. I Give unto my Eldest Daughter Sally Bails five Shillings
Likewise five Shillings to my Daughter Balthiah Milikin, Likewise
I Give five Shilling to each of my Daughters (Covett), Agnes,
Hartwell, Amy, Susannah, Polly, & Betsey —
Item. I Desire that my well beloved Wife Mary Pasmore may
have the use of my Plantation & the Land belonging it & all
the Rest of my Goods & Chattles During her Life & After her Decease
the 2^d Land & Plantation to be Right & property of my Youngest
Son Alexander Pasmore Likewise I Desire that after her Decease
all the Rest of my Goods & Chattles may be Equally Divided
Between my three Sons John, Housman, & Alexander Pasmore
& my six Youngest Daughters Covett, Agnes, Hartwell, Amy,
Susannah, Polly, & Betsey Pasmore, —
Lastly. I Constitute & appoint my son in law John Milikin
& David M. D.

all the Rest of my Goods & Chatties may be Equally Divided
Between my three Sons John, Hausman & Alexander Pasmore
& my six Youngest Daughters Louisa, Agnes, Harriett, Amy,
Suzannah, Polly, & Betsey Pasmore, — — —

Lastly. I Constitute & appoint my son In Law John Millikin
& my wife Mary Pasmore, my Whole & Soul Executors & Sec^{rs}
of this my Last Will & Testament Disannulling all other
Wills by me heretofore by me made Whereunto I have set my
hand & fixed my seal this 30.th January 1785.
