In the Name of God Amen I Robert Jones of the County of Halifax and State of North Carolina being of sound & perfect mind & memory blessed be God for the same & knowing the time appointed for all men to die do make & publish this my last Will & Testament, first recommending my Soul into the hands of Almighty God as I have been taught such to do & to be with it both before God to bless me with in this life & hereafter in the following manner viz. This my Will and desire that all my Just debts be paid by my Executors hereafter named & the residue of my property both real & personal I give bequeath and demise to my beloved wife Rachel Jones during her natural life or widowhood & after her death or marriage my Will & desire is that my son John Jones pay to her all the aforesaid property which I give to my said wife Rachel Jones, to him the said John Jones his heirs and assigns for ever. And hereby appoint, make & ordain My beloved wife Rachel Jones my sole & sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament, revoking & disannulling all other Will or Wills heretofore by me made & Ratifying & Confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament. In testimony whereof I the said Robert Jones have to this my last Will & Testament, Set my hand & seal this 27th Day of August Anno Dom. 1794
