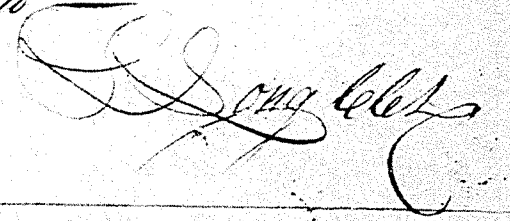

In the Name of God Amen, I Robert Hall of the County of Halifax and State of North Carolina being very weak in Body but of perfect sound mind and memory do make and Ordain this to be my last Will and Testament as follows I give to my wife one feather bed and furniture, one Christ, three Chairs, one pine Table, two pots, one dish, one Bason, 5 plates, one Hat box, six barrels Corn, four hundred Weight of Pork, one Spinning wheel & Looms, to her during her Widowhood the ballance of my Estate after all debts are paid to be equally divided between my two sons David & Burgess to them & their heirs forever. I hereby Appoint my sons David & Burgess Executors to this my last Will & Testament, I leave to Charlotte Hall one Shilling Henry Hall one Shilling Harwood Hall one Shilling. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 11th day of September 1799—
