George Williamson and his Heirs forever, my Negro Boy Suckles and three Bunches Cash
Secondly I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Frances Williamson and her
Heirs forever, Ten Negroes, Hannah and Judith and in case my Daughter should
die without lawful Issue then it is my Will and Pleasure that my Negro Girl ^{putate} should
go to my Son George Williamson and his Heirs forever and my other Negro Girl
Hannah to descend to my Son John Williamson and his Heirs forever. I Give to my
Daughter Susannah Macrett my Negro Girl called Lucy during her life and it is
my Will and Pleasure that after my Daughter Susannah Macrett's decease, my
Negro Girl Lucy should descend to my Granddaughter Elizabeth Macrett and her Heirs
forever, and if the said Negro Girl Lucy should have Issue it is my Will and Pleasure
that her second Child should descend to my Grandson Thomas Macrett and his Heirs
forever. I Give and bequeath to Son John Williamson my Negro Fellow called
Will: to him and his Heirs forever, and a Negro Man called Frank and a
Negro Girl called Sillocks to him and his Heirs forever, and the Rest of my Personal
Estate I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Williamson and her Heirs
forever. Lastly I Give and bequeath to my Sons, George &
John Williamson Executors of my last Will and Testament and do hereby utterly
disallow, revoke, and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies
Bequests and Executors, by my or any other way before this since named, Made and
bequeathed, Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and
Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal
the day and Year first above written. Signed, Sealed, Published, pronounced and

 my Will and Pleasure that after my Daughter Susannah Hackett's decease, my
 Negro Girl Lucy should descend to my Granddaughter Elizabeth Hackett and her Heir
 forever, and if the said Negro Girl Lucy should have Issue it is my Will and Pleasure
 that her second Child should descend to my Grandson Thomas Hackett and his Heir
 forever. I Give and bequeath to Son John Williamson my Negro Fellow called
 Will^m to him and his Heir forever, and a Negro Man called Frank and a
 Negro Girl called Jilber to him and his Heir forever, and the Rest of my Personal
 Estate I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Williamson and her Heir
 forever. Lastly I likewise constitute make and Ordain, my Sons George &
 John Williamson Executors of my last Will and Testament and do hereby utterly
 disallow, revoke, and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Will, Legacies
 Requests and bequests, by any means other Way before this since named, Made and
 bequeathed, Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and

in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & sixty four, I William Sargison
of Halifax County being in very weak in Body, tho in my perfect, Memory, Mind and Senses, Pleased
to God first, and therefore calling to mind the Mortality of my self and knowing it is appointed for
all Men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament: That to say Principally
and first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of God to his Mercies and for my Body I recom-
mend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like Manner and decent at the discretion of my
Executors after named Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection shall revive the same
again by the Mighty Power of God: And as touching such Things as any Worldly Estate that the
God has blessed me in this life I first desire and dispose of in the following
Manner & Form, First I desire that all my Estate to hold by my Executors and of
their Discretion without any Hindrance or Obstacle to pay all my lawful debts of such things
as my Wife can spare, but, Also will and desire that my Executor after named may sell my Land and
Plantation at Public Auction and half the Money he find ready down, and the rest the Purchaser
to have Three Months Credit giving Bond and Security, and I will and desire that everything
due of my Estate both within Doors and without be lent to my Dear Wife for her Supportance
and I hereby lend the same to her during the time of her natural life and as for her death I
desire it to be equally divided between my two children, Namely Sarah Sargison to the
my Wife is fifty with if both alive and if but one should live I desire that one shall have it
all I therefore constitute share and ordain my Brother Nemrod Sargison and my Wife Jane
Sargison my only sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament, and do hereby utterly
disallow Repulse and disannul all and every other Testaments Wills, Legacies and Executors
made in any kind by me named Willed and bequeathed ratifying and Confirming this and Wishes
to be my last Will and Testament, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand &
