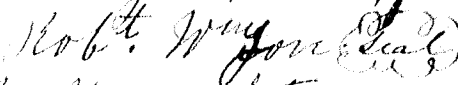
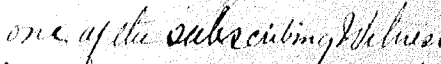


In the Name of God Amen the fifteenth day of March in the

George Williamson and his Heirs forever, my Negro Boy Buckles and three Bunches Cash
Secondly I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Frances Williamson and her
Heirs forever, Ten Negroes, Hannah and Judah and in case my Daughter should
die without lawful Issue then it is my Will and Pleasure that my Negro Girl ^{putate} should
go to my Son George Williamson and his Heirs forever and my other Negro Girl
Hannah to descend to my Son John Williamson and his Heirs forever. I lend to my
Daughter Susannah Mackett my Negro Girl called Lucy during her life and it is
my Will and Pleasure that after my Daughter Susannah Mackett's decease, my
Negro Girl Lucy should descend to my Granddaughter Elizabeth Mackett and her Heirs
forever, and if the said Negro Girl Lucy should have Issue it is my Will and Pleasure
that her second child should descend to my Grandson Thomas Mackett and his Heirs
forever. I Give and bequeath to Son John Williamson my Negro Fellow called
Will to him and his Heirs forever, and a Negro Man called Frank and a
Negro Girl called Silke to him and his Heirs forever, and the Rest of my Personal
Estate I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Williamson and her Heirs
forever. Lastly I Give and bequeath to my Sons, George &
John Williamson Executors of my last Will and Testament and do hereby utterly
disallow, revoke, and disannul all and every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies
Bequests and Executions, by my many other Wills before this since named, Wills and
bequeathed, Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and

forever, and if the said Negro Girl Lucy should have Issue it is my Will and Pleasure
that her second child should descend to my Grandson Thomas Shacklett and his heirs
forever. I Give and bequeath to Son John Williamson my Negro Fellow called
Will to him and his heirs forever, and a Negro Man called Frank and a
Negro Girl called Silly to him and his heirs forever, and the Rest of my Personal
Estate I Give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Williamson and her heirs
forever. Lastly I likewise constitute make and Ordain, my Sons George &

bequeathed, Ratified and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and

Executors after named Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection shall receive the same
again by the Mighty Power of God: And as touching such Things as any Worldly Estate that with
God has blessed me in this Life I first desire and dispose of in the following

to have Twelve Months Credit giving Bond and Security, and I wish and desire that everything
due of my Estate both within Doors and without be lent to my Dear Wife for her Supportance
and I thereby lend the same to her during the Time of her natural Life and as for her Death I
desire it to be equally divided between my two Children, Namely Sarah Sargison to the
my Wife is living with if both alive and if but one should live I desire that one shall have it
all I therefore constitute make and ordain my Brother Nemrod Sargison and my Wife Jane
Sargison my only sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament and do hereby utterly
disallow Repulse and Disavow all and every other Testaments Wills, Legacies and Executors
made in any Manner or named Will and Legacies ratifying and Confirming this and Nothing
to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand &
