last Will and Testament, in manner and from the following
Lived and Principals, I Give good Report unto my soul
into the hands of almighty God; hoping through the
Devils death and Revision of our Blessed Lord and
saviour Jesus Christ, to Receive free Pardon and forgiveness
of all my sins, and for my self, and for my body,
Commit to the Earth to be buried in a Christian
like Manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter
Mentioned, and as for my Wholly Estate as it shall
Please God to take with me this life I Give and
bequeath in Manner and form following by my
Will and Desire is that all my debts and just charges
be Paid and discharged; Item, I Give and bequeath
to my well beloved friend Suffia Corp all my Estate
both Real and Personal at the time of my death
and hereby I do appoint the aforesaid Suffia
Corp sole and sole heir of this my last Will and Testament
and I do hereby appoint Jane Corp daughter of the said
Suffia Corp Guardian to see this Well Executed
and to take into her Possession what so ever shall belong to
me at my death for the use of the heir till she shall attaint
the Age of sixteen Years and then to be delivered into her
Possession and the heir to be Maintained as far as the Estate
will allow lawfullly can be if the said heir should die
before she attaineth the age of eighteen then the Estate to go to
the next surviving heir, and I Revokes and Disannul all
Wills I have made here to me made and do allow this

in the Name of Almighty God, supporting whom you will
Pray for the Death and Passion of our Blessed Lord and
saviour Jesus Christ, to Receive free Pardon and of myne many
of all my Sins, and for my Help, and for my Soul
Committe the Faith to be shewd in a Shewte and
like Manner at the Discretion of my Executor hereafte
Mentioned, and as for my Whilfull Estate as it shall
Please God to helpe me with in this life I Give and
bequeath in manner and forme following by my
Will and Desire is that all my debts and charges
be Paid and discharged; Item. I Give and remeind Regardfull
to my Will folow'd I suffe Corp of all my Estate
both Real and Personal at the time of my death
and heareby I do appoint the aforesaid Crippen
Corp sole good well heir of this my last Will and Testament
and I do heartily appoynt Josue Corp sonne of the said
Suffe Corp Testator to see this Will Executed
and to take into his Possession what so ever shall belong to
me at my death for the use of the heir till she shall attaine to
the age of sixteen years and then to be delivered into her
Possession and the heir to be maintained as farre as the Estate
will allow carefullly and if the said heir should dye
before she attains to the age of sixteen then the Estate to go to
the next surviving heir, and I Provoke and command all
Witnesses here to make record I do allow this
and no other to be my Last Will and Testament Roger Layton *Test*
In witness whereof I have hereunto set

my hand & seal this 6 day of August 1763

Then this Will was exhibited in open Court and was duly
Proovid by the oaths of John Scott a Witnessesse there to and
their being no Executor, Adm' Cun; Test. Eliz: on all and
singular the Goods and Chattels Rights and Creditors,

whole sum of the Estate of Roger Taylor deceased is one
million granted to George Rierton having been bound
with William Langores & William Branch set in £600
and was duly finalised by taking the oaths by Mr
