And as to the balance of my Estate both Real & Personal I desire it should be Equally divided between all my Children to wit Eliza Pullen, Leroy Pullen, Chancy Pullen, Clara Pullen, William Pullen, John Pullen, Charlotte Pullen, Peter Pullen, Willie Pullen & Nancy Pullen Equally Share & Share alike. I do appoint My dear & Beloved wife Charlotte Pullen My sole Executrix & my Leroy Pullen John Mathews My Executors to settle my last Will & Testament. I do hereby disannul & revoke all other wills & Testaments & I do publish & Pronounce this to be my last Will & Testament in writing whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name this 25th day August. 1794

Item I give & bequeath to my beloved son Julius Horton my last plantation to which I now live also I give to my son Julius one more fifth by the name of Peter.
