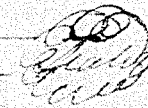

In the Name of God Amen, I Sarah Carter of Halifax County being
of sound and perfect mind & memory, blessed be God, this 21st day of May
in the year of our Lord 1799 make and publish this my last will and
Testament in manner following that is to say — First, I give and bequeath
to my son Phillip one flatter Bed and Furniture thereunto belonging —
Then I give to my daughter Francis Tull one flatter bed with the furniture
thereunto belonging also three earthen bowls — Then I give to my Grand daughter
Nancy daughter of Jesse one Cow — Then I give to my son Jesse all my flock
of Cattle & Hogs with all the residue of my Estate of what ever kind or nature
soever that I have not hitherto given and I hereby make and Ordain my
son Jesse and Miller & Barbara Executors of this my last will and Testament,
in witness whereof I the said Sarah Carter have to this my last will and
Testament set my hand at the day and year above written —
